Prepare Your New Brush For Painting.

With any new natural bristle hair paint brush it's perfectly normal to have a few loose bristle hairs. Follow our five step guide to minimize bristle shedding.



2: PLUCKUse your finger tips to gently pull and pluck out any loose bristles that you see.



4: RINSE

Gently rinse your brush in warm water then work the bristles back-and-forth with the tips of your fingers.



1: SLAP
Slap the bristles against your hand or a hard surface several times to loosen and expose any roque bristles.



3: KNIFE / SWEEPUsing the back of the knife by pulling the hair towards you in a sweeping motion over the entire brush head.



5: X-ing

Dip the brush in paint (1/3 the bristle length) and paint back/forth over newspaper print in an "X" pattern.
